



Individual Quota Point Rules Sheet

Format: Each player is given a point quota based on his handicap. Points will be scored: bogey=1, par=2, birdie=4, eagle=8. Gross scores only. Player whose point total for 18 holes most exceeds their point quota (or comes closest if none exceed quota) wins. Individual quota is listed on your scorecard. On the scorecard, enter the gross score and points earned for each hole.

Tournament Regulations

1. **Local and U.S.G.A. Rules govern all play.**
2. Men will play the **BLUE** tee, Women will play the **RED** tees.
3. Out of Bounds defined by white stakes, property fences, and paved roads or sidewalks.
4. Red stakes define lateral hazards; yellow stakes define direct hazard.
5. Hole #8, Please use drop zone located on right side of pond at 175 yards out.
6. With any questions on rulings, play a second ball finishing the hole with two balls and refer to tournament committee at end of event for correct ruling.

Slow Play, NO ONE Likes It!

1. Please keep pace with the group in front of you. The committee will assess penalty strokes for slow play.
2. Each group is allowed a maximum of 2 hours and 5 minutes on the front and 2 hours and 10 minutes on the back.
3. ***You do not gain or lose any points after a bogey. If you're out of the hole, please pick up and move to the next hole***
